The Volcano

A volcano is a mountain and it has an opening that leads to a pool of molten rock from below the surface of Earth. Lava and hot ash will flow out from the volcano, causing much damage to whatever comes in contact.

A volcano is formed from molten rocks underground in the deepest layers and it can take hundreds of years to form.

The largest volcano is located in Hawaii and measures almost 4000 meters and the highest volcano measures almost 7000 meters.
