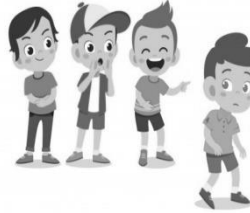

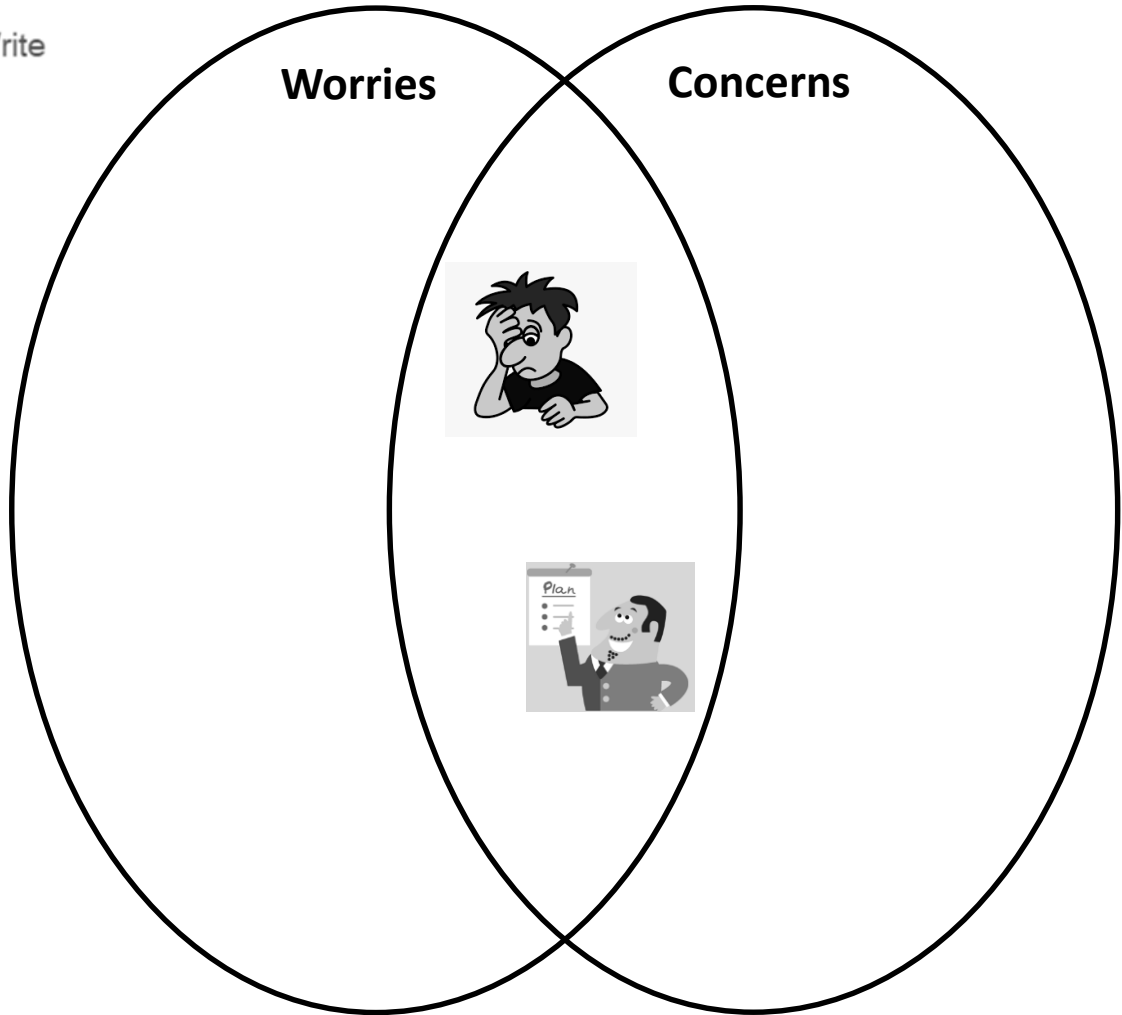

- Thank you, mom.

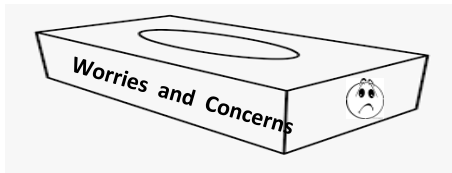

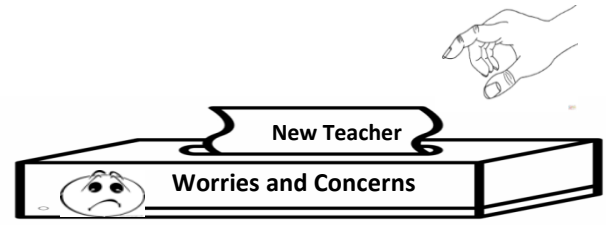
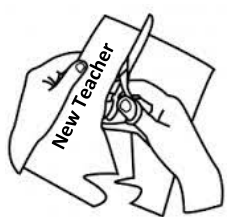
- A box

Instructions:

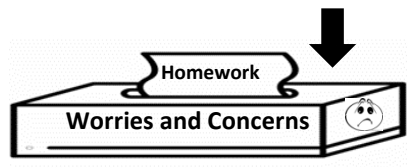
1. Decorate the box.
