

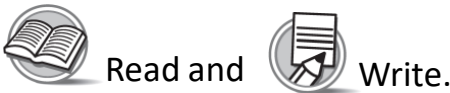

The Cheeky Mouse

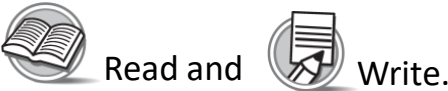
