



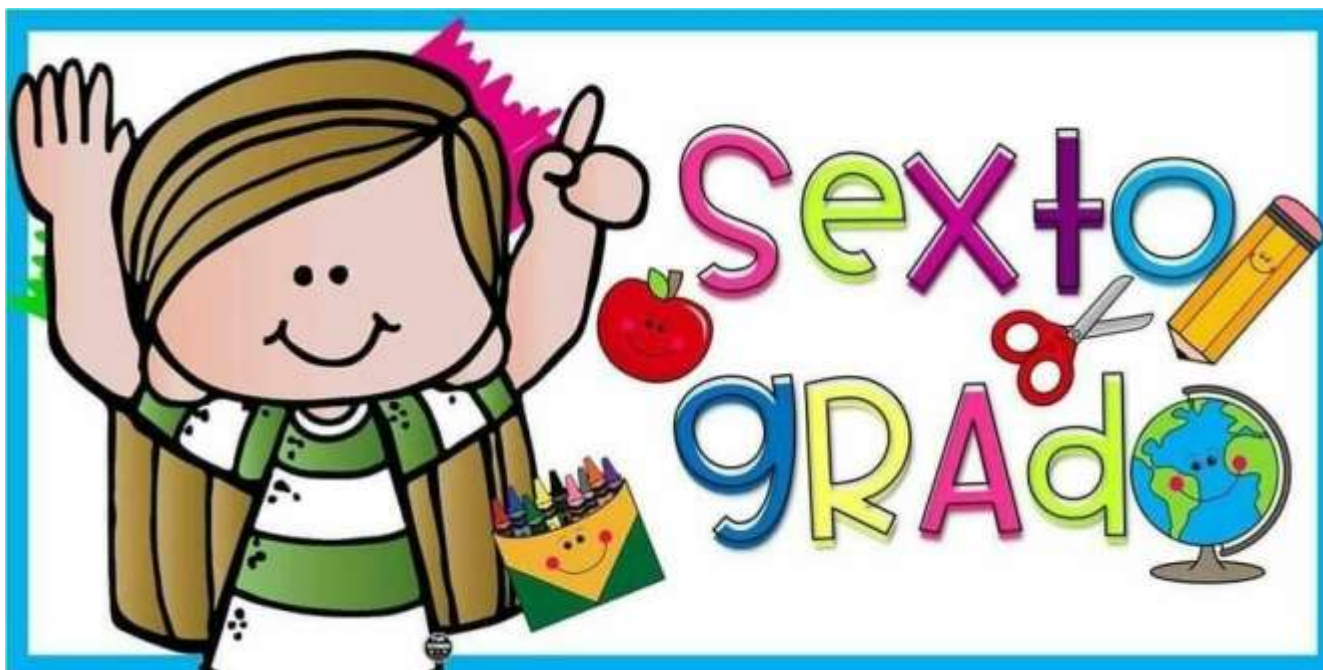

A comic strip is a narrative medium used to express ideas with images, often combined with text or other visual information.

It typically takes the form of a sequence of panels of images. Textual devices such as speech balloons, captions, and onomatopoeia can indicate dialogue, narration, sound effects or other information.

Some comic book types are: superhero, humor, non-fiction, science-fiction, horror. They are typically printed in a newspaper or comic book.
