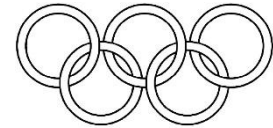

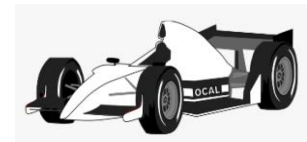

On November 11th, 2009, the “Territorio Santos Modelo” was officially inaugurated by the President of Mexico.

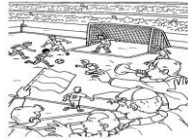

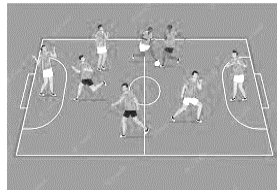

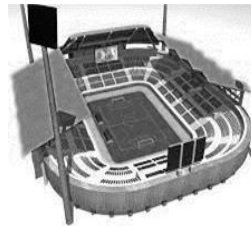
